### A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY FOOD STORAGE FACILITY FOR USE BY WICAP

**WHEREAS**, Boise County has acquired an 8" x 10" Stor-Mor building through a Community Services project, and said building is currently placed on Boise County property in Horseshoe Bend; and


**WHEREAS**, the Boise County Commission has been informed there is a need for an emergency food storage facility that meets certain criteria, the Boise County Commission resolves to do the following.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the primary designated use of this building will be for storage of emergency food to serve the needs of the Boise County residents, and said building shall be used to store emergency food from WICAP and private donations for such endeavors to meet those needs. The said building requires various improvements to meet the minimum standards for emergency food storage, which Boise County will not assume the cost thereof or any liability there for. Any improvements or upgrades to this building shall not be construed as a basis to claim ownership or interest in said building.

This agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year, subject to renewal by the Boise County Commission. The Boise County Commission shall give 90 days notice of termination of this agreement to WICAP.


