A RESOLUTION TO SURPLUS AND SELL AN EAST BOISE COUNTY AMBULANCE DISTRICT AMBULANCE

WHEREAS, East Boise County Ambulance District has transitioned from use of their 1996 Atlas Medtec ambulance, VIN 1GBJK34F2TE210660, and has determined that this ambulance no longer meets the needs of their operation; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners has determined that selling the 1996 Atlas Medtec ambulance would garnish additional revenue for the East Boise County Ambulance District and would reduce costs in storage and insurance; and


WHEREAS, Idaho Statute 31-808 authorizes the Boise County Board of Commissioners to sell equipment or goods to the public by closed bid.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners has approved the surplus and sale of one (1) 1996 Atlas Medtec ambulance (VIN: 1GBJK34F2TE210660) to be sold by closed bid to the highest bidder and from which all proceeds will be receipted into the East Boise County Ambulance District revenues.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the minimum bid on the 1996 Atlas Medtec ambulance shall be set at \$6,000.


