A RESOLUTION TO SURPLUS AND TRANSFER AN EAST BOISE COUNTY AMBULANCE DISTRICT AMBULANCE TO THE PLACERVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, East Boise County Ambulance District has transitioned from use of their 1995 Chevy Medtec ambulance, VIN 1GBJK34F4SE179717, and has determined that this ambulance no longer meets the needs of their operation; and

WHEREAS, Placerville Volunteer Fire Protection District has expressed a desire to own and utilize this same vehicle as a rescue vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners has determined that transferring the 1995 Chevy Medtec ambulance would be a better use of the vehicle and provide the most benefit to the citizens of Boise County; and


WHEREAS, Idaho Statute 31-808 authorizes the Boise County Board of Commissioners to transfer or donate equipment or goods to another governmental entity; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners has approved the surplus and transfer of one (1) 1995 Chevy Medtec ambulance (VIN: 1GBJK34F4SE179717) from the East Boise County Ambulance District to the Placerville Volunteer Fire Protection District with the intent that said vehicle shall not be used for transport services in which Boise County reserves the right to take back possession of said vehicle.


