A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO GIVE AUTOMATIC EXTENSIONS FOR SUBDIVISION APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners is required to implement a subdivision ordinance under Idaho Code 67-6513;

WHEREAS, under Chapter 9, Section 1.A., of the Boise County Subdivision Ordinance states "HARDSHIP: Where the Board finds that extraordinary hardship will result from strict compliance with this ordinance, it may vary the requirements or standards thereof so that substantial justice may be done and the public interest secured.";

WHEREAS, the building and development in Idaho has greatly declined due to economic conditions;


WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners has identified that due to these recent economic conditions, strict compliance with the ordinance requirements will result in extraordinary hardship by the land use applicants;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that any and all subdivision applications submitted prior to the day this Resolution is signed may receive an automatic 2-year extension from the date the final plat is due.

APPROVED and **ADOPTED** in Open Session on 14, day of December 2009.


