ROW Utility

GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. No Construction after November 1st.
2. All utilities must be **installed under** any culverts they cross.
3. All structures (i.e., telephone pedestals, transformers, etc.) will be located as far from county roadway as possible to prevent damage from snow removal operations. All structures will be marked with snow markers for easy location in the winter.
4. During the progress of the work, such barricades, lights and other traffic control devices shall be erected and maintained as may be necessary or as may be directed for the protection of the traveling public. Said barricades; lights and other traffic control devices shall conform to the current issue of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
5. In accepting this permit, the Permittee, its successors and assigns, agrees to hold Boise County harmless from any and all liability on account of the erection, installation, construction, maintenance or operation of the facilities located under this permit.
6. Any disturbance of the traveled surface of the road and/or traffic control devices shall be restored to the satisfaction of Boise County. Permittee shall be responsible for proper pavement cut, excavation, backfill, compaction and asphalt repair. Asphalt repair shall be in accordance with Exhibit 3 – Figure C, 1, – Manual for Use of Right of Way – Permits for Utilities and Encroachments.
7. If the work done under this permit interferes in any with the drainage of the highway, the Permittee shall wholly and at his own expense make such provision as Boise County may direct to take care of said drainage.
8. On completion of said work herein contemplated, all rubbish and debris shall be immediately removed and the roadway and roadside shall be left neat and presentable to the satisfaction of Boise County.
9. This permit shall not be deemed or held to be an exclusive one and shall not prohibit Boise County from granting other permits or franchise rights or like other nature to other public or private utilities, nor shall it prevent Boise County from using any of its public right-of-way, or public places, or affect its right to full supervision and control over all or any part of them, none of which is hereby surrendered.
10. Boise County may revoke, amend, amplify, or terminate this permit or any of the conditions herein enumerated if Permittee fails to comply with any or all of its provisions, requirements or regulations as herein set forth or through willful or unreasonable neglect, fails to heed or comply with notices given, or if the utility herein granted is not installed or operated and maintained in conformity.
11. The Permittee shall maintain at its sole expense the structure or subject for which this permit is granted.
12. Adequate drawings or sketches shall be included showing the existing and/or proposed location of the facility with respect to the existing and/or planned location of the highway improvements, the traveled way, the public right-of-way lines and approved access points.
13. If trench or pavements settlement should occur within two (2) years from the date of installation, repairs shall be made by the Permittee as directed by Boise County at no cost to Boise County. If the Permittee fails to make the necessary repairs, Boise County will make the repairs and bill the Permittee. No new permits shall be issued to the Permittee until such claim has been settled.
14. Permittee shall notify Boise County to schedule a time for road closure and opening. If the work will prevent emergency traffic from traveling through, local law enforcement office must be notified.
