

RESOLUTION NO. 96-8

A resolution authorizing collection of telephone line user fees for funding in whole or part for the 911 Emergency Communication System as authorized by the Emergency Communication Act Title 31, Chapter 48, Idaho Code.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Boise County Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. As a result of the passage of the Boise County line user fee advisory ballot on May 28, 1996, the Boise County Commissioners hereby authorize pursuant to Idaho Code 31-4804 the imposition of a telephone line user fee.

2. The telephone line user fee shall be in the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) per month per exchange access line, trunk line, network access register, or equivalent.


3. U.S. West Communications, Citizens Telecom, and Cambridge Telephone Company, Inc., and their successors or assigns are hereby directed to commence the imposition of the monthly telephone user fee at the monthly rate as set forth in paragraph 2, commencing July 1, 1996.

4. U.S. West Communications, Citizens Telecom, and Cambridge Telephone Company, Inc., and their successors or assigns are hereby authorized to deduct and retain three fourths of one percent (.75 percent) of the collected amount as the cost of administration for collecting the charge. Further, U.S. West Communications, Citizens Telecom, and Cambridge Telephone Company, Inc., will be encouraged to list the surcharge of the telephone line user fee as a separate item on the telephone subscriber's bill, and shall have no obligation to take any legal action to enforce the collection of any charge, nor be held liable for such uncollected amounts.


