

## RESOLUTION #97-26

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE BOISE COUNTY BUDGET TO REFLECT THE RECEIPT OF UNSCHEDULED REVENUE TO THE 911 SYSTEM

WHEREAS, Boise County will receive funds from multiple utility companies for 911 telephone service; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the budget to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue from State, Federal, and private agencies; and


WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment, and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that monies received for the purpose of the 911 telephone system be budgeted as follows:


Anticipated Revenue	\$34,558.61
