NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to Section 63-1305B, Idaho Code, and a Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Boise County, Idaho (the "County"), adopted on March 30, 2012, a special election will be held in the County on

TUESDAY, MAY 15, 2012

between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. for the purpose of enabling the qualified and registered voters of the County to vote on the following question:

SHALL THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BOISE COUNTY, IDAHO, BE AUTHORIZED TO EXERCISE THE POWERS AND AUTHORITIES PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 63-1305A, IDAHO CODE, BY CERTIFYING A BUDGET INCREASE FOR THE 2012-2013 FISCAL YEAR, AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, IN EXCESS OF OTHER LIMITATIONS IMPOSED BY LAW, IN AN AMOUNT IN EACH YEAR NOT TO EXCEED A LEVY RATE OF ONE-TENTH OF ONE PERCENT (0.1%) ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE COUNTY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING A FINAL JUDGMENT AGAINST THE COUNTY, ALL AS PROVIDED IN SECTIONS 63-1305A AND 63-1305B, IDAHO CODE?

Qualified electors shall vote at the following locations:

Crouch Community Hall, Horseshoe Bend Courthouse, Boise County Courthouse, Lowman Emergency Services Station #80, Wilderness Ranch Fire Station, Centerville Fire Station and Absentee - Boise County Recorder's Office

Only qualified and registered electors eighteen (18) years of age or older who have resided in the State of Idaho and in the County for at least thirty (30) days next preceding the election, and no others, will be permitted to vote at the special election. No person so qualified and registered and offering himself or herself at the polling place at which he or she is entitled to vote will be denied the privilege of voting at the special election.


Electors of the County may register at the office of the Boise County Clerk, Miner's Exchange Building, 420 Main Street, Idaho City, Idaho, until April 20, 2012. Any person who is eligible to vote may register on election day by appearing in person at the polling place established for the special election, by completing a registration card, making an oath on the form prescribed by law and providing proof of residence in the manner provided by section 34-408A, Idaho Code, as amended.

Any qualified elector may vote by absentee ballot in the manner provide by law.


If a majority of the qualified and registered electors voting at the special election vote in favor of the budget increase proposition as set forth in this Notice, the Board of Commissioners of the County will certify an increase in the property tax portion of the budget of the County, in an amount not to exceed a levy rate of one-tenth of one percent (0.1%) on all taxable property in the County, in addition to all other levies permitted by law and in excess of the limitations of Section 63-802, Idaho Code, beginning with the fiscal year which commences on October 1, 2012, and continuing for each fiscal year thereafter, for the purpose of paying a final judgment against the County, all as authorized by Sections 63-1305A and 63-1305B, Idaho Code.


