A RESOLUTION TO SURPLUS AND SELL THE MORES CREEK AMBULANCE BUILDING AND LAND

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners and the East Boise County Ambulance have determined that the building and land of the former Mores Creek Ambulance, located on a portion of Lot 8, Block 2 of Rimview Subdivision No. 1, Boise County, Idaho, are no longer necessary to its operation; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-808 and 829 authorizes the Boise County Board of Commissioners to sell equipment or goods which are deemed no longer necessary to the needs of the County; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners approve the surplus of the building and land as identified herein:

1.695 acres of land with a well and septic in place and a building (1200 sq. ft.)

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the surplus building and land shall be sold by sealed bid to the public and that the minimum bid accepted shall be \$35,000.00 (certified funds). Boise County reserves the right to reject any and all bids.


