RESOLUTION #2013-57 A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO DECLARE A DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there is threat to life and property in **BOISE COUNTY** as the result of landslides along Boise County roads, which resulted from thunderstorms on September 5th, 2013; and

WHEREAS, a disaster emergency as defined in Section 46-1002, Idaho Code, is in existence in **BOISE COUNTY**, due to the imminent threat to life and property created by loss of highway access to residents and unincorporated properties of **BOISE COUNTY**; and

WHEREAS, Section 46-1011, Idaho Code, authorizes the Commissioners of **BOISE COUNTY**, Idaho to declare a disaster emergency to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance, thereunder;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and declared by the **BOISE COUNTY** Board of Commissioners, as follows:


1. A disaster emergency is hereby declared to exist within **BOISE COUNTY**, created by the thunderstorms and creating an imminent threat to life and property and;
2. These conditions require the activation of the response and recovery aspects of all applicable local disaster emergency plans and;
3. Such disaster may require state emergency assistance to supplement local efforts to protect, rehabilitate and replace public property and to provide a coordinated multi-agency effort to mitigate, avert and lessen the threat and impact of the disaster.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND DECLARED a disaster emergency so to activate without delay, the response and recovery aspects per the Boise County Emergency Operations Plan, as unanimously concurred to by the Board of Commissioners via teleconference and approved to be signed by Chair Barbara M. Balding at 10:00 PM September 6th, 2013.
