A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE A WORKERS' COMPENSATION MEDICAL PROVIDER

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioner has determined it is in the best interest as an employer to be proactive in their approach in returning injured workers to the job and minimizing time-loss; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners acknowledges there are providers who specialize in occupational medicine and the treatment of work-related injuries and illnesses; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners has determined drug testing and employment physicals can also be provided by the designated medical provider; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners has determined after hour coverage is needed; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners has determined a designated medical provider can lower costs for Boise County and improve outcomes for our employees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners designates St. Luke's Occupational Health who shares our proactive approach to return-to-work, can provide care 24/7 and will work with Boise County to achieve the best health outcome.


