### A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO ADJUST THE FY 2014 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS 911 FUND BUDGET FOR UNANTICIPATED EXPENSES

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2014 budget, for the Boise County Emergency Communications 911 Fund was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, under Idaho Code Section 31-1608, the Board of County Commissioners may, upon the adoption of a resolution, by unanimous vote of the commissioners, make expenditures necessary to meet mandatory expenditures required by law; and

**WHEREAS**, the expenditures may be paid from the fund properly chargeable with such expenditures; and

**WHEREAS**, Boise County is legally required to provide emergency services through the established Boise County Emergency Communications System; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual budget procedure has been complied with, in making the said adjustment, and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the FY 2014 budget, for the Boise County Emergency Communications 911 Fund, be adjusted as follows:
