A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE FY 2015 BOISE COUNTY JUSTICE FUND BUDGET

WHEREAS, the FY 2015 budget, for the Boise County Justice Fund, Sheriff's Department, was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on September 2nd, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 63-805(2) allows the Board of County Commissioners to make a general reserve appropriation, for use in the event of any unforeseen contingency arising, which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the budget and which shall require the expenditure of money not provided for in the budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, by unanimous vote, shall have the right to make an appropriation from the general reserve appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the Justice Fund, Sheriff's Department, expended funds for public safety during the Karney Fire, in September of 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has made a determination of Boise County's liability associated with the Fire Management Assistance Grant (FMAG) issued for the Karney Fire 2012; and

WHEREAS, monies budgeted within the Justice Fund, Justice General Reserve Department, need to be transferred to the budget of the Justice Fund, Sheriff's Department, to pay for this liability; and


WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the FY 2015 budget for the Boise County Justice Fund, Sheriff's Department, be adjusted for:




