## RESOLUTION #2016-33

### A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION SETTING THE COMMUNITY JUSTICE DEPARTMENT DIVERSION PROGRAM FEES

**WHEREAS**, the Boise County probation department may be utilized to resolve a criminal charge or infraction, through a process described as informal disposition, which is done without involvement in the court process, and informal disposition is most effectively done using the Boise County Community Justice diversion program; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to set a program fee to defray the cost of programming rendered and services utilized by Boise County Community Justice, for informal disposition; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the program fee, participation in diversion may include referrals to an outside agency for treatment or other programming; for the costs of drug and/or alcohol testing; or for any applicable restitution; the cost of which shall be borne by the participant in addition to the program fee.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Boise County Board of Commissioners, that the diversion program fee be set at an amount of \$100.00 up to \$200.00; and

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** any request for a reduction in the diversion program fee is to be done, in writing, to the Boise County Community Justice Director. And, the Director, with good cause, has the authority to reduce the program fee.
