A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO ADJUST THE FY 2016 BUDGET FOR THE JUSTICE FUND, SHERIFF'S RESERVES DEPARTMENT, FOR: THE WALKER FIRE

WHEREAS, the FY 2016 budget for the Justice Fund, Sheriff's Reserves Department, was adopted by the Boise County Board of Commissioners on August 25th, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the budget; as adopted, to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue, grants, or donations from federal, state or local governments or private sources, provided that there shall be no increase in anticipated property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Justice Fund, Sheriff's Reserves Department, has incurred unanticipated expenses and received unanticipated revenues associated with the Walker Fire; and,

WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the FY 2016 budget for the Justice Fund, Sheriff's Reserves Department, shall be increased as follows:


