OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Ward called the meeting to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

Commissioner Jackson SECONDED. Roll call vote: Chairman Ward – Aye; Commissioner Jackson – Aye; Commissioner Stirm - Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Chairman Ward brought the meeting out of executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(f) pending litigation, per I.C. 74-206(1)(b) personnel, per I.C. 74-206(1)(d), exempt records, per I.C. 74-206 (1)(a), to hire an employee and per I.C. 74-206(1)(i) risk management, no action required.

MINUTES: Commissioner Jackson MOTIONED to accept the minutes for Tuesday, June 11th, 2019, as written. Commissioner Stirm SECONDED; All Ayes.

DEPARTMENTAL ISSUES: A letter confirming the ratification of Commissioner Stirm filling the remainder of the term on the Central District Health Committee was presented and discussed. Chairman Ward MOTIONED that Commissioner Stirm fill in as Boise County's representative on the Central District Health Board, replacing Commissioner Baker's term which will end June 30th, 2019, and to include the next five (5) year term from July 2019 until June 2024. Commissioner Jackson SECONDED; All Ayes. A form to register Commissioner Stirm for the National Association of Counties Conference was presented for signature. Chairman Ward MOTIONED to sign the NACO 2019 Credentials voting form. Commissioner Jackson SECONDED; All Ayes. Community Justice Administrator Leader discussed with the Board the possible employee picnic to be held in July. Solid Waste/Noxious Weeds Superintendent Rekow presented a change order to the Board on the retaining wall at the Garden Valley transfer station, discussion ensued. Chairman Ward MOTIONED to approve the change order in the amount of \$593.50 to add a twelve (12) foot fence on top of a wing wall as per request through RC Hayes Construction and Solid Waste of Boise County. Commissioner Jackson SECONDED; All Ayes. Emergency

Management Coordinator Showalter presented documentation to the Board on the possible purchase of a Mobile Command Center, discussion ensued. Assessor Juszcak presented documentation to the Board on the purchase of a vehicle from Mountain Home Auto Ranch, discussion ensued. Commissioner Stirm MOTIONED to approve the purchase of an Assessor's vehicle, 1500 Classic Tradesman Quad Cab four (4) wheel drive purchase from Mountain Home Auto Ranch, in the amount of \$23,741.00. Commissioner Jackson SECONDED; All Ayes. Prosecuting Attorney Strong discussed software in his office with the Board. Sheriff Kaczmarek spoke with the Board concerning the new homes being built in Avimore as well as the concern of law enforcement coverage for the area.
