GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. No Construction after November 1st.
2. Application fee to be paid to Boise County before permit will be issued. Schedule of fees shall be the latest adopted by Boise County Board of Commissioners on file with the County Clerk.
3. Any public right of way approaches shall be for the bona fide purpose of securing access and not for the purpose of parking, conducting business, or servicing vehicles on the public right-of-way. Location of road approach shall have a line of sight a minimum of 200 feet or greater in both directions. No revisions or additions shall be made to an approach or its appurtenances on the public right-of-way without the written permission of Boise County.
4. The Permittee shall furnish all material, labor, and equipment involved in the maintenance of the public right of way. This shall include furnishing approved drainage pipe of a size specified on permit, curb and gutter, etc., where required. Materials and workmanship shall be good quality and are subject to inspection and approval by Boise County. Boise County reserves the right to waive such inspection in writing.
5. Boise County reserves the right to require the Permittee, its successors and assigns, at any time, to make such changes, additions, repairs and relocations to the public right of way or any approach or its appurtenances within the public right-of-way as may be necessary to permit the relocation, reconstruction, widening, drainage, and maintenance of the roadway and/to provide proper protection to life and property on or adjacent to the roadway.
6. Adequate drawings or sketches shall be included showing the design, materials, construction requirements and proposed nature of the right of way maintenance.
7. During the public right of way maintenance, such barricades, signs and other traffic control devices shall be erected and maintained by the Permittee, as may be deemed necessary by Boise County or to provide for public safety. Said devices shall conform to the current issue on the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
8. In accepting this permit, the Permittee, its successors and assigns, agrees to indemnify and hold Boise County harmless from any liability caused by the installation, construction, or maintenance of the public right of way. This provision shall be supported by Permittee's showing of a current Certificate of Liability Insurance of not less than \$500,000 per occurrence before the permit is issued.
9. If the work done under this permit interferes in any way with the drainage of the roadway, the Permittee shall wholly and at his own expense make such provision as Boise County may direct to take care of said drainage problem.
10. Upon completion of said work herein contemplated, all rubbish and debris shall be immediately removed and the roadway and roadside shall be left neat and presentable to the satisfaction of Boise County.
11. Neither the acceptance of this permit nor anything herein contained shall be construed as a waiver by the Permittee of any rights given by the constitution or laws of the State of Idaho or of the United States.
12. Permittee acknowledges that the public right of way is open to the public and under the jurisdiction of Boise County and the Boise County Road department, however Boise County and its Road Department has no legal obligation to construct or maintain the right of way.
