A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE FY2010 JUNIOR COLLEGE BUDGET FOR UNEXPECTED EXPENSES

WHEREAS, the FY2009/2010 budget for the Junior College Fund was adopted by the Boise County Board of Commissioners based upon anticipated revenue and expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Junior College Fund had unexpected expenses due to an increased number of Boise County residents who requested tuition assistance to attend the State's junior colleges; and

WHEREAS, the Junior College Fund has sufficient cash carryover to cover these additional expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners under Idaho Code 31-1508 has the authority to transfer funds; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-1605 allows the Board to adjust the budget by resolution; and


WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes.

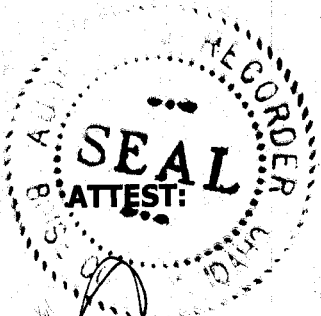


