A RESOLUTION TO ORDER THE TRANSFER OF VEHICLE TITLE TO DISPOSE OF A 1986 PIERCE/FORD SUBURBAN PUMPER TRUCK TO LOWMAN VOLUNTEER FIRE DISTRICT, INC.

Whereas, The Board of Commissioners of Boise County have the authority under Idaho Code 31-604 (4) to make such orders for the disposition or use of its property as the interests of its inhabitants require; and

Whereas, Lowman Volunteer Fire District, Inc. has demonstrated the advantages of such vehicle to provide firefighting, fire protection, or other emergency services to its service area for five years under a lease agreement; and

Whereas, The Board of Commissioners of Boise County has reviewed the circumstance and it has been satisfactorily demonstrated to the Board of Commissioners that Lowman Volunteer Fire District, Inc. can adequately carry out their function and transferring ownership would provide the most benefit to the citizens of Boise County;

Whereas, it has been determined to be advantageous to the public to make certain equipment available; and

It is Hereby Resolved and Ordered: The Boise County Board of Commissioners in the County of Boise, State of Idaho, approves the disposal and transfer of title of one (1) 1986 Pierce F8000 Pumper Truck (VIN 1FDRK84N3GVA48266) to Lowman Volunteer Fire District, Inc.
