**Whereas,** the County is desirous of retaining the law firm of Moore Smith Buxton & Turcke, Chartered, of Boise, Idaho, as bond counsel to the County for services in connection with the settlement and seeking the issuance, sale and delivery of funds to pay the Order in Alamar Ranch.

### **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:**


Section 1: The Boise County Board of Commissioners hereby appoints the law firm of Moore Smith Buxton & Turcke, Chartered, of Boise, Idaho, as special counsel and bond counsel for any and all matters arising out of the Alamar Ranch Settlement and Order and to seek the issuance, sale and delivery of bonds, if possible, to meet the terms of the Order issued in the Alamar Ranch litigation and pay the registered warrants associated therewith.


Section 2: This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
