**OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES**

Chairman Fry called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

**PRESENT:** Chairman Fry, Commissioner's Day and Anderson and Clerk Prisco.

The purpose of the meeting was to continue a workshop, to discuss ideas for communications for a May 2012 special election, as provided by the recently passed legislation.

Commissioner Anderson suggested that a number of documents from the Alamar trial(s), including the ICRMP lawsuit, be posted on the county website. Clerk Prisco agreed to locate final court documents, as well as other public documents, with the ultimate purpose being to post the documents to the county website.

Chairman Robert A Fry made a MOTION to amend the agenda to add, in the afternoon, to discuss which expenditures should be provided for public information purposes. Commissioner Terry C Day SECONDED. Roll call vote: Commissioner Day-aye; Chairman Fry-aye; Commissioner Anderson-aye. Motion carried unanimously.

A number of county departmental 2012 budgets were discussed, including the P&Z and Prosecuting Attorney departments. The Commission then discussed what information might be included in a press release as well as how the county website could be utilized to provide information.

Commissioner Terry C Day made a MOTION to allow for funding of Tom Jensen, Veridean Technology, to provide website services to enhance the Boise County website to include public education on Alamar and the upcoming election (in May, 2012). Chairman Robert A Fry SECONDED. All ayes; motion passed.

Having no further business, Chairman Fry adjourned the meeting until 9:00 a.m. on Monday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
