A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION AMENDING THE DISTRIBUTION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE FEES AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2003-16

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the need to rescind Resolution 2003-16, which put in place the original distribution schedule for emergency medical service fees collected by the County, per Idaho Code Section 49-452; and

WHEREAS, the Crouch Ambulance unit no longer exists and those ambulance services are now being provided by the Garden Valley Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 49-452 allows (\$.25) twenty-five cents per motor vehicle registration fee, collected for emergency medical services, to be retained by the County of residence for use in funding local emergency medical costs; and

WHEREAS, there exists three distinct ambulance units in Boise County, consisting of the East Boise County Ambulance District, Horseshoe Bend Ambulance (under the City of Horseshoe Bend), and Garden Valley Fire Protection District, all of which provide emergency medical services to Boise County; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Boise County Commissioners does hereby rescind Boise County Resolution #2003-16, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Boise County Commissioners sets forth the following annual distribution of each (\$.25) twenty-five cents collected for emergency medical services, and accrued in the EMS Fees Trust (trust account 9118):

- East Boise County Ambulance District 50%
- Horseshoe Bend Ambulance (City of Horseshoe Bend) 25%
- Garden Valley Fire Protection District 25%

RESOLUTION #2003-16

**A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION SETTING
EMS FEES DISTRIBUTION**

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §49-452 allows (\$.25) twenty-five cents of motor vehicle registration fee collected for emergency medical service be retained by the county of residence for use in funding local emergency medical service costs; and

WHEREAS, there are three distinct ambulance units in Boise County that consist of East Boise County Ambulance, Horseshoe Bend Ambulance and Crouch Ambulance which provide emergency medical service to Boise County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners sets forth the following distribution of the Emergency Medical Service Fees and establishes an EMS Trust.

East Boise County Ambulance	50%
Horseshoe Bend Ambulance	25%
Crouch Ambulance	25%

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolution #2003-16, to be known as the Boise County EMS Fees Distribution, be effective October 1, 2002.

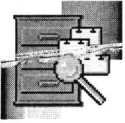

Idaho Statutes

TITLE 49 MOTOR VEHICLES

CHAPTER 4 MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION

49-452. EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FEE. (1) An emergency medical services fee of one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) shall be collected in addition to each motor vehicle registration fee amount collected under the provisions of this chapter, with the exception of those vehicles proportionally registered under section 49-435, Idaho Code. Twenty-five cents (25¢) of the fee shall be retained by the county of residence for use in funding local emergency medical service costs. One dollar (\$1.00) of the fee shall be transmitted to the state treasurer for deposit in the emergency medical services fund established in section 56-1018, Idaho Code.

(2) For vehicles registered under the provisions of section 49-402B, Idaho Code, the fee shall be two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50). Fifty cents (50¢) of the fee shall be retained by the county of residence for use in funding local emergency medical services costs. Two dollars (\$2.00) of the fee shall be transmitted to the state treasurer for deposit in the emergency medical services fund established in section 56-1018, Idaho Code.
