



BOISE COUNTY ORDINANCE #2022-01

BOISE COUNTY Littering Ordinance

ESTABLISHING AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT PLACING DEBRIS ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY IS A MISDEMEANOR; SETTING FORTH PENALTIES; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BOISE COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO as follows:

SECTION I - SHORT TITLE

A. This ordinance shall be known as the Boise County Littering Ordinance.

SECTION II - PURPOSE

A. To protect Boise County roadways, public property and private property from littering.

SECTION III - DEFINITIONS

A. All words and phrases used in these sections shall be given their ordinary, commonly understood and accepted meanings.

SECTION IV - VIOLATION AND PENALTY

A. It shall constitute a misdemeanor for any person, to deposit upon any public or private property within this state any debris, paper, litter, glass bottles, glass, nails, tacks, hooks, hoops, cans, barbed wire, boards, trash, garbage, lighted material or other waste substances on any place not authorized by any county, city, village or the owner of such property, and is punishable by a fine of not less than three hundred dollars(\$300) and not more than one thousand dollars(\$1000)and punishable by a term of jail of not less than two (2) days in jail and not more than six(6) months in jail. A second conviction under this section within ten (10) years of the commission of the prior offense for which the person was convicted shall constitute a misdemeanor and be punishable by a fine not less than five hundred dollars(\$500) and not more than one thousand dollars(\$1000). Such second offense shall also be punishable by a term of jail not less than five (5) days and not more than six (6) months. All jail under this section may be converted to community service to be completed in Boise

County at the rate of 8 hours per day of Jail in the discretion of the sentencing judge.

SECTION VI - SEVERABILITY

- A. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any provisions of this ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid for any reason, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION VII - AUTHORITY

- A. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority vested in Boards of County Commissioners in the State of Idaho under Idaho Code 31-714, and the Idaho Open Meeting Law, Idaho Code 67-2340 et seq.


SECTION VIII - REPEAL

- A. The provisions of this ordinance shall repeal all previously enacted resolutions or ordinances pertaining to the operation of vehicles on groomed snowmobile trails.

SECTION IX - EFFECTIVE DATE

- A. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
