RESOLUTION #2022-21

A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO DECLARE AS SURPLUS AND TRANSFER NOXIOUS WEEDS NO-TILL DRILL

WHEREAS, the Boise County Noxious Weeds Department has in its possession, a Seed Drill, 8 foot with fertilizer box, tow hitch and electric acre meter, also known as a No-Till Drill, with a depreciated value of \$13,925; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Boise County Commissioners (hereinafter "Board") have determined that the No Till Drill and attachments, are no longer required, and the Noxious Weeds Department has no further need of them in any aspect of their operations; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-808 and 31-829 authorize the Board to sell equipment or goods at public auction, or dispose of select items, which are deemed no longer necessary to the operation of the County; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-808 (9) authorizes the Board to grant to or exchange real or personal property with the Federal government, State of Idaho, any political subdivision or taxing district of the State of Idaho or any local historical society which is incorporated as an Idaho nonprofit corporation that operates primarily in the county or maintains a museum in the county, with or without compensation, after adoption of said resolution by the Board; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board has approved the surplus and transfer of the following items identified as: Seed Drill (also known as) No-Till Drill to the Squaw Creek Soil Conservation District, a taxing district of the State of Idaho.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board shall dispose of them in accordance with the law.
