**OFFICIAL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**

**IN ATTENDANCE:** Chairman Twilegar, Commissioner Tucker, Commissioner Stirm, Prosecuting Attorney Strong, Deputy Clerk Coffelt, Planning & Zoning Administrator Gross, Sheriff Turner, Assessor Juszczak, Solid Waste Administrator Allred, Planning & Zoning Legal Counsel Brown (Naylor & Hales, P.C.), Planning & Zoning Permit Tech II Barnhill.

**ABSENT:** Clerk Prisco.

Chairman Twilegar called the meeting to order.

**REQUEST TO PURCHASE VEHICLES:** A retail purchase agreement for two (2) vehicles for the Sheriffs' Office was presented to the Board for review and discussion. Sheriff Turner did state on the record that three (3) bids were requested and only two (2) quotes were provided. Chairman Twilegar MOTIONED to approve the vehicle purchase of two (2) vehicles, in the amount of \$49,523.08 per vehicle from Steve's Hometown in Fruitland. Commissioner Stirm SECONDED; All Ayes.

**DEMAND WARRANT(S):** Two (2) Demand Warrants were presented to the Board for review, discussion ensued. Chairman Twilegar MOTIONED to pay the demand warrant to Hometown Chevrolet Buick GMC Inc., in the amount of \$49,523.08 for a 2022 Chevy Truck, fund number 54-00 and account number 0801-00. Commissioner Stirm SECONDED; All Ayes. Chairman Twilegar MOTIONED to pay the demand warrant to Hometown Chevrolet Buick GMC Inc., in the amount of \$49,523.08 for a 2022 Chevy Truck, fund number 03-01 and account number 0801-00. Commissioner Stirm SECONDED; All Ayes.

**APPEAL OF PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION DECISION:** Chairman Twilegar opened the public hearing for the appeal to the Planning & Zoning Commission decision of the Crowfoot shooting range. Chairman Twilegar went over the rules and regulations of the public hearing for the record. Planning & Zoning Administrator Gross gave an overview of the application and how it had progressed to the point of an appeal to the Board. The appellant, Ms. Terri Pickens Manweiler for Pickens Law, P.A. presented the case of her clients to the Board as to the many reasons why the decision of the Planning & Zoning Commission should be overturned. Mr. Matthew Parks, representing the Crowfoot Shooting Range, presented his rebuttal to the Board, pointing out the Conditions of Approval that the Planning & Zoning Commission had put into place, discussion ensued. Chairman Twilegar opened the public testimony portion of the hearing and stated the rules for the individuals who wanted to speak. Ms. Angela Vavra, Ms. Melissa Johnson, Dr. Neal Vavra, Rick Williamson, Ms. Timber Haskins, Mr. Malcolm Haskins, Horseshoe Bend Fire Chief Jeffery Johnson, Mr. Maurice Messensmith, Ms. Aimee Ricci, Mr. Peter Staples, Mr. Norm Zachary, Ms. Julie Townsend, Mr. Steve Loomis, Ms. Susan Holland, Mr. Alan Townsend, Mr. Ryan Haskins, and Mr. Jay Hutchinson testified before the Board. Chairman

Twilegar closed the public testimony portion of the public hearing. Mr. Matthew Parks presented a rebuttal to the Board about the concerns from the public testimony, discussion ensued. Ms. Terri Pickens Manweiler provided closing comments on behalf of the clients.

Chairman Twilegar brought the meeting out of executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(d), exempt records, no action required.

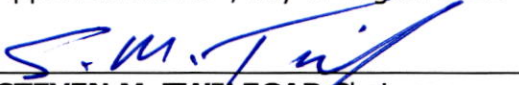
