OFFICIAL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

IN ATTENDANCE: Chairman Twilegar, Commissioner Tucker, Prosecuting Attorney Strong, Clerk Prisco, Deputy Clerk Coffelt, Planning & Zoning Administrator Gross, Sheriff Turner, Planning & Zoning Legal Counsel Brown (Naylor & Hales, P.C.).

VIA TELECONFERENCE: Commissioner Stirm.

Chairman Twilegar called the meeting to order.

IDAHO CITY CARPORT ADDITIONAL ELECTRICAL BID APPROVAL: A bid was presented to the Board for additional electrical work on the carport at the Idaho City Road & Bridge Shop for review and discussion. Chairman Twilegar MOTIONED to approve the carport electrical work in the amount of \$2,500. Commissioner Tucker SECONDED; All Ayes.

LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION APPROVAL: Two (2) retail alcoholic beverage license applications were presented to the Board for review, discussion ensued. Chairman Twilegar MOTIONED to approve the retail alcoholic beverage license application for Dustin Weniger at the Redline Outdoor Adventures LLC/Spring Shores Marina. Commissioner Tucker SECONDED; All Ayes.

Chairman Twilegar MOTIONED to approve the retail alcoholic beverage license application for David Johan at the Corner Café Bar & Grill in Horseshoe Bend. Commissioner Tucker SECONDED; All Ayes.

CONTINUED APPEAL OF PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION DECISION: The deliberation among the Board members continued, discussion of additional conditions of approval were stated on record.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Chairman Twilegar MOTIONED to enter into executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(d), exempt records to discuss any issues and obtain updates on ongoing matters falling under the motioned executive session codes. Commissioner Stirm SECONDED; Roll Call Vote: Chairman Twilegar – Aye; Commissioner Tucker – Aye; Commissioner Stirm – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Chairman Twilegar brought the meeting out of executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(d), exempt records, no action required.

CONTINUED APPEAL OF PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION DECISION: Chairman Twilegar read onto record the Planning & Zoning Commission conditions of approval, along with the additions of the conditions of approval from the Board of County Commissioners. Chairman Twilegar MOTIONED to uphold the Planning & Zoning Commission decision to approve the Crowfoot Shooting Range with the findings, and conditions of approval, modifications that have

been discussed by the Board. Commissioner Tucker SECONDED; Chairman Twilegar – Aye; Commissioner Tucker – Aye; Commissioner Stirm – Nay. Motion Carries.

Chairman Twilegar adjourned the meeting until the regular meeting of Tuesday, September 6th, 2022.
