RESOLUTION #2022-40

A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE BOISE COUNTY SOLID WASTE FUND TO THE BOISE COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE FUND

WHEREAS, the FY 2022 budget, for the Boise County Road & Bridge Fund, was adopted, by the Board of County Commissioners on August 31st, 2021, via Resolution 2021-39; and,

WHEREAS, a budget amendment was made via Resolution 2022-18, for the paving project of approximately 2 miles of Old Emmett Rd., as well as a Change Order Request to that paving project, for an additional .6 miles to pave up to the Horseshoe Bend Transfer Station; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, the Road & Bridge Superintendent, and the Solid Waste Superintendent, mutually agreed for the Solid Waste Fund to reimburse the Road & Bridge Fund, for the cost of paving in front of the Horseshoe Bend Transfer Station building; and,

WHEREAS, the Road & Bridge Fund properly invoiced the Solid Waste Fund, for the cost of paving in front of the Horseshoe Bend Transfer Station building and said transfer of funds was made; and

WHEREAS, the annual budget has been complied with, in making the said adjustments, and the budget adjustments shall not result in increased property taxes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Boise County Board of Commissioners approves the budget amendment for the transfer of funds, in the amount of \$16,590.89, from the Boise County Solid Waste Department to the Boise County Road & Bridge Department, as reflected within the Road & Bridge Fund, as follows:


