OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES

IN ATTENDANCE: Acting Chairman Stirm, Commissioner Tucker, Clerk Prisco, Deputy Clerk Coffelt, Prosecutor Strong, Assessor Juszczak, Sheriff Turner, Solid Waste/Noxious Weeds Superintendent Rekow, Road & Bridge Superintendent Dill, Community Justice Administrator Leader, Wildland Fire Mitigation Forester/Emergency Manager Richardson.

Acting Chairman Stirm called the meeting to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

CONSTITUENT INPUT: None at this time.

MINUTES: Acting Chairman Stirm MOTIONED to approve the official meeting minutes for October 18th, 2022, as written. Commissioner Tucker SECONDED; All Ayes.

DEPARTMENTAL ISSUES: Solid Waste/Noxious Weeds Superintendent Rekow presented two (2) payroll change requests to the Board for review, discussion ensued. Acting Chairman Stirm MOTIONED to approve the payroll change for a transfer station attendant #1 from temporary; less than twenty (20) hours, to permanent part time; still less than twenty (20) hours. Commissioner Tucker SECONDED; All Ayes. Acting Chairman Stirm MOTIONED to approve a payroll change request for an employee from Noxious Weeds, uncertified sprayer; to a Solid Waste, transfer station attendant II. Commissioner Tucker SECONDED; All Ayes. Sheriff Turner presented documents to the Board for compensation to the Dispatch employees which are understaffed at this time, discussion ensued, the matter was table to the meeting of November 1st for further discussion and review of impact to FY 2023 budget.

Acting Chairman Stirm brought the meeting out of executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(f), pending litigation, and per I.C. 74-206(1)(d), exempt records, no action required.

Acting Chairman Stirm adjourned the meeting until Tuesday, November 1st, 2022.


