Thanks for the phone call this morning, I was able to speak with our special uses program manager regarding your inquiry on any special parking permit needs for your proposed yurt village on private lands. The Forest Service has no separate permitting requirements; however, I'd like to remind you that if your patrons are using the Park-n-Ski lots in the winter time, they will need to purchase the Park-n-Ski pass offered by Idaho Parks and Rec in order to park there. In the summer time, there are not specific parking stipulations. I would also like to remind you that for the upcoming summer, Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) will be performing road work on State Highway 21 between Mores Creek Summit and Beaver Creek Summit. This road work will begin after the July 4th holiday and last approximately six weeks. I know they just recently received bids for the road work, but I do not know who the successful bidder is that got awarded the job. I have attached some preliminary information that was shared with the Forest Service back in July. For the most up-to-date information, it would be wise to contact Greg Vitely, the ITD project lead for that road work. His contact information is below:
