RESOLUTION #2018-16

A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROJECT APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THE BANKS_LOWMAN ROAD PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Boise County Commissioner ("Board") is required to lay out, maintain, control and manage public roads and bridges within the County under Idaho Code 31-805; and

WHEREAS, the Board is empowered to exercise general supervision over all highways in the county highway system, including their reconstruction, repair and maintenance under Idaho Code 40-604; and

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to make agreements with the state, the United States and its departments and agencies for the construction, reconstruction, or maintenance of the counties highway system under Idaho Code 40-604; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-602 entrusts the Board with conducting all aspects of county business within the bounds of law; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-706 requires that the Board to take official measures and solidify county business decisions, upon the existence of at least two members of the Board to constitute a quorum; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-801 grants the Board in their respective counties all jurisdiction and authority within the legal confines of their statutory office; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-802 empowers the Board with authority to supervise the duties and conduct of all county officers; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-828 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to perform all other acts and things required by law, not otherwise articulated within Idaho Code "which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the board as chief executive authority of the county government;" and

WHEREAS, the Banks-Lowman Road provides critical access to the communities of Crouch and Garden Valley and is required to support the emergency services and economy of Boise County; and

WHEREAS, the damaged culvert and slope protectors at MP 6.75 is causing the fill slope to fail and threatens to undermine Banks-Lowman Road and make it unsafe to the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, the Idaho Office of Emergency Management (IOEM) is accepting requests for funding eligible projects; and

WHEREAS, the Banks-Lowman Road MP 6.75 project will cost approximately \$509,000 and the County is required to provide \$50,900 (10%) as a match, in addition to be potentially responsible for cost overruns; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board approve this project application and submit it to the Idaho Office of Emergency Management for approval and prioritization.
