dump in Lowman was effective until December of 1984. Assessor Jack Craig was present and discussed with the Board a request he had received from Calvin Drake for reduction in taxes on logging equipment assessed from a report he had previously submitted to the Assessor. Following discussion, Chairman Yensen moved the request be denied and that Mr. Drake be notified to personally appear and give testimony under oath if he would like the Board to reconsider his request. Commissioner Baumhoff seconded the motion. Motion passed. Treasurer Carlyne Reed informed the Board that she had refused to certify as required on the final at of Mores Creek Crossing as there are to date taxes due on that subdivision which was approved by the board in December, 1982. The Clerk was instructed to contact the developers of the subdivision to see if it is their intention to file the final plat. Indigent Claim of John L. Moore was reviewed. Commissioner Baumhoff moved that 1) the following claims be paid: David W. Becker, Jr.--\$1,515.71; Boise Orthopedic Clinic--\$539.00; St. Alphonsus Radiology Group--\$10.10; Boise Anethesia--\$148.75; Ada County EMS --\$85.00 and B.E.S.T.--\$150.00; for a total of \$2,448.56 and 2) that a claim from St Alphonsus in the amount of \$2,960.74 be denied for lack of funds in the Indigent Account and 3) that the Prosecuting Attorney be instructed to research if the County can file a lien on real property that the Moore's could possibly have an interest in. Commissioner Fry seconded the motion. Motion passed. Assessor Craig discussed with the Board property contained within the East 1/2 of East 1/2 of Section 4, Township 8N, Range 8E and the Clerk was instructed to write property owners with reference to Idaho Code 50-1314. Following discussion, Chairman Yensen moved that the following resolution be passed: RESOLUTION Whereas, the Boise County Board of Commissioners have determined that because of the unusually heavy snow fall this winter and because the fast thawing has created unforseen road problems on Boise County Roads, and whereas under 31-1608 of the Idaho Code, the Board of Commissioners have the authority to take necessary measures. Now therefore be it resolved by the Boise County Board of Commissioners that a weight limit of 14,000 pound per axle be placed on all Boise County Roads until further notice.
