

**RESOLUTION #2000-14**

**A RESOLUTION OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE WORKFORCE  
INVESTMENT PROGRAMS IN SOUTHWEST IDAHO**

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998 has rescinded the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA); and

WHEREAS, the WIA relies on the sponsorship of local workforce development programs by the Chief Local Elected Officials (LEOs) as defined by the Governor of each State; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Local Elected Officials has designated the IDA-ORE Planning and Development Association, Inc. (IDA-ORE) as the LEO grantee and administrative entity for southwestern Idaho; and

WHEREAS, the LEOs in southwestern Idaho have been represented, collectively, by IDA-ORE for the previous 17 years; and

WHEREAS, the designated LEO and its partner, Southwest Idaho Private Industry Council (PIC) have historically incurred no questioned costs; and


WHEREAS, the new WIA program requires LEOs to commit to assume financial and programmatic liability; and

WHEREAS, it is in the joint interests of the local governments of southwestern Idaho to provide locally managed workforce development programming for the individual and regional economic benefit of our region;



APPROVED and ADOPTED by the Boise County Board of Commissioners in open session on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May 2000.


