RESOLUTION # 2001-16 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING DESIGNATED SMOKING AREAS WITHIN BOISE COUNTY OWNED BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Boise County, Idaho, have determined that in order to protect the public health and comfort and the rights of non-smokers, and further to protect county buildings from fire danger, and

WHEREAS, smoking includes carrying a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other matter or substance which contains tobacco, and

WHEREAS, this resolution shall pertain to all Boise County Employees as well as the general public,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that no persons shall, after the effective date of this resolution, smoke within the confines of any Boise County Buildings other than those enclosed offices that have an adequate ventilation or filter system and have notified the Board that they have met these requirements. Adequate is defined as sufficient ventilation or filter system as to not impact non-smokers entering the space.
