

RESOLUTION #2001-23

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE FY 2000-2001 EAST BOISE COUNTY AMBULANCE BUDGET TO ALLOCATE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE

WHEREAS, East Boise County Ambulance has received unanticipated revenue of \$23,268.26 in the FY 2000-2001 budget year; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the Budget to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue from State and Federal Governments, and private agencies; and

WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the amount of \$23,268.26 be placed in the East Boise County Ambulance Fund and the budget reflect the increase of said amount, as follows:
