

RESOLUTION #2001-08

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Boise County Board of Commissioners to dispose of county personal property that has become obsolete, worn, or damaged so as to require replacement in a timely and effective manner according to I.C. §31-829; and

WHEREAS, any elective county officer must first have the consent of the Board of County Commissioners to dispose of said personal property.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1) That each Elective County Officer may dispose of Boise County personal property with a value less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), which is of no further use to the county, by presenting a list of said property to the Board of County Commissioners for consent to dispose of appropriately; and
- 2) That all cash received from the sale of personal property will be turned in to the county treasury.


This Resolution shall be effective upon date of adoption.

PASSED and ADOPTED this 22 day of January 2001.




