

RESOLUTION #2002-21

DECLARATION of LOCAL EMERGENCY (Idaho Code section 46-1011)

WHEREAS, severe rain and thunderstorms traveled through Boise County on Sunday, April 14, 2002, and;

WHEREAS, these same storms caused major mud and rock slides on the Banks/Lowman Road at mile marker 2.5, and on the Harris Creek road at mile marker 11.0, and;

WHEREAS, it appears to the Boise County Board of Commissioners that:

- 1. An emergency does exist in Boise County as of 12:30 p.m. on April 14, 2002,
- 2. Local County and private resources may not be adequate to handle this emergency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, and DECLARED by the Boise County Board of Commissioners at 12:30 p.m. on the 14th day of April, 2002, as follows:

- 1. An emergency exits within Boise County resulting from severe thunderstorms;
- 2. Such emergency may require outside emergency assistance to supplement local efforts and to avert the impact of the emergency.


