A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE JUNIOR COLLEGE BUDGET FY 2001-2002

WHEREAS, the Board of Boise County Commissioners has reviewed the FY 2001/02 Budget Revenue for the Junior College Fund and has determined a shortfall in the projected revenue and expense for the budget; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 33-2110A provides for the funding of the Junior College Fund through State Liquor Allocations and County levying authority; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Boise County Commissioners has received more Junior College applications than anticipated when setting the FY 2001/02 Junior College Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Boise County Commissioners allocate the amount of \$900.00 from the State of Idaho Liquor Allocations from the Current Expense Fund and the Justice Fund into the Junior College Fund.






