

RESOLUTION #2002-28

DECLARATION of LOCAL EMERGENCY (Idaho Code section 46-1011)

WHEREAS, Boise County is experiencing Wildland fires and weather conditions that may impact the health and safety of residents.

WHEREAS, electrical energy has been interrupted caused by heavy weather conditions including tree limbs falling across power lines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is declared by the Board of Boise County Commissioners, Boise County, Idaho, that a local emergency does exist due to heavy weather and Wildland fires that are creating a threat to the safety of county residents through the interruption of electrical energy. We request that the State Police suspend service hours for Idaho Power for a period of five days as a result of this emergency unless further extended by emergency declaration.

APPROVED AND ADOPTED as a Resolution at the regular meeting of the Boise County Board of Commissioners on the 15th day of July 2002, upon motion made by Commissioner Jackson, seconded by Commissioner Hanson.
