



RESOLUTION #2003-17

A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION SETTING RETAIL SALE OF PORT, SHERRY AND MADEIRA WINES

WHEREAS, pursuant to enactment of Chapter 119, 2003 Session Laws of the State of Idaho, by the Fifty-seventh Legislature, First Regular Session, the Boards of County Commissioners of the several counties of the state of Idaho, are authorized to adopt a resolution authorizing the sale of Port, Sherry, and Madeira wines within the several counties by person holding a retail wine license issued by the Director of the Idaho State Police; and

WHEREAS, the retail sale of table wines with Boise County has previously been approved for, and within Boise County, and it appearing to the Board of County Commissioners that it would be reasonable and not adverse to the public interest to permit the sale of Port, Sherry and Madeira wines, as defined by Chapter 119, 2003 Session Laws of the State of Idaho.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners that the sale of Port, Sherry and Madeira wines, known as dessert wines and as defined by Chapter 119, 2003 Session Laws of the State of Idaho, be and the same is hereby permitted within Boise County, by persons holding a retail wine license issued by the Director of the Idaho State Police and holding a retail wine license issued by Boise County.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Director of the Department of Idaho State Police.
