



RESOLUTION #2005-11

A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Boise County has identified the need for a transportation plan in cooperation with the various cities within the county in order to create a multi-jurisdictional planning group for the purpose of addressing transportation issues county-wide, and;

WHEREAS, the county and cities within the county are in the process of creating a multi-jurisdictional transportation planning group, and;

WHEREAS, the federal government offers funding for such groups in the form of grant funding, and;

WHEREAS, obtaining grant funding requires that an application to the LOCAL HIGHWAY TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE COUNCIL (LHTAC) be filed in order to prioritize the grant funding request, and;

WHEREAS, Boise County is requesting funding for a total project cost of approximately \$180,000.00; \$18,000.00 of which shall be required from Boise County as matching local funds upon grant approval.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board supports this LHTAC project and commits itself to the required matching local funds upon grant approval, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes and directs its Chairman, Roger Jackson, to sign the identification packet and to submit it to LHTAC for prioritization.
