RESOLUTION #2006-51

A BOISE COUNTY EMERGENCY DECLARATION

WHEREAS, severe forest fires are burning in Boise County and the surrounding counties of Valley, Gem, Elmore and Custer; and

WHEREAS, current and forecast weather predictions point to continued adverse weather that will likely enhance the spread of fire in Boise County; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial for Boise County to support the Disaster Declarations and fire fighting efforts in adjoining counties by the means of joint operations; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Boise County Board of Commissioners that:

1. An emergency is in existence in Boise County,
2. An emergency exists which County and private resources will not be adequate to handle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED be it resolved and declared by the Boise County Board of Commissioners at 9:00 p.m. Tuesday Sept 05, 2006 as follows:

1. An emergency exists within Boise County resulting from severe forest fires;
2. Such emergency may require outside emergency assistance to supplement local efforts and to avert the impact of the emergency.

APPROVED and ADOPTED, as a Resolution during the regular meeting of the Boise County Board of Commissioners on this 11th day of September, 2006, upon a motion made by Commissioner Lawson, seconded by Commissioner Stutzman.
