

## RESOLUTION #2006-51

## A BOISE COUNTY EMERGENCY DECLARATION

WHEREAS, severe forest fires are burning in Boise County and the surrounding counties of Valley, Gem, Elmore and Custer; and

WHEREAS, current and forecast weather predictions point to continued adverse weather that will likely enhance the spread of fire in Boise County; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial for Boise County to support the Disaster Declarations and fire fighting efforts in adjoining counties by the means of joint operations; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Boise County Board of Commissioners that:

- 1. An emergency is in existence in Boise County,
- 2. An emergency exists which County and private resources will not be adequate to handle.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** be it resolved and declared by the Boise County Board of Commissioners at 9:00 p.m. Tuesday Sept 05, 2006 as follows:

- 1. An emergency exists within Boise County resulting from severe forest fires;
- 2. Such emergency may require outside emergency assistance to supplement local efforts and to avert the impact of the emergency.
