## RESOLUTION NO. 2007-17

### A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO DEMAND THE COMPLETE REMOVAL OF CANADIAN WOLVES FROM BOISE COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, the health, safety and livelihood of the citizens of Boise County are the responsibility of the Boise County Commissioners who are duly elected by the citizens of Boise County; and

**WHEREAS**, the elected County Commissioners of Boise County do hereby condemn the government agency (U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service) for introduction and/or DUMPING Canadian wolves within the boundaries of Boise County, which are deemed by the Boise County Commissioners to be a threat to public health, safety and livelihood; and

**WHEREAS**, it is a well documented and scientific fact that the Canadian wolf is an UNCONTROLLABLE and DEADLY threat to man; and

**WHEREAS**, Canadian wolves in Boise County have decimated our big game herds, caused serious livestock predation, killed family pets, caused loss of wildlife viewing, and drastically impacted our customs and culture – damaging our local “Mom and Pop” businesses – the Board of Boise County Commissioners hereby deem Canadian wolves to be a threat to public health, safety and livelihood; and

**WHEREAS**, because of the LIES, MYTHS, FRAUD SCIENCE and BIOLOGY by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and their continued BLATANT and FLAGRANT out-of-control “Canadian Wolf Recovery Plan,” Boise County is now in the worst wildlife disaster in its history.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Boise County Commissioners declare the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service in is VIOLATION of Ordinance No. 29 by DUMPING Canadian Wolves into Central Idaho and Boise County.

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that the citizens of Boise County have petitioned the Commissioners of Boise County to ask for PROTECTION, and therefore, it is the responsibility of the Boise County Commissioners to take ANY and ALL actions necessary to protect its citizens.

**IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Boise County Commissioners STRONGLY supports the Idaho Legislature CONCURRENT RESOLUTION HOUSE JOINT MEMORIAL NO. 5, which calls for and DEMANDS, in the STRONGEST MANNER, that the Canadian wolf recovery efforts in Idaho be discontinued IMMEDIATELY and Canadian wolves be REMOVED BY WHATEVER MEANS NECESSARY.
