A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR AN IDAHO GEM GRANT FOR A CLEAN HEAT AND POWER FEASIBILITY STUDY

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners wishes to support and encourage appropriate efforts within the community that promote economic development of the community and the economic well-being of its citizenry; and
