

ORIGINAL **BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2008-29** A RESOLUTION TO ADJUST THE FY 2007/2008 EBCA BUDGET TO ALLOCATE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE

WHEREAS, Boise County's East Boise County Ambulance Department has received unanticipated revenue from Department of Health & Welfare for an EMS – Interop Grant for Radios in the FY2008 Budget year in the amount of \$87,781.32; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the Budget to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue from State and Federal Governments, and private agencies; and

WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the FY 2007/2008 Budget for East Boise County Ambulance Departments' Fund be increased and expended in the amount of \$87,781.32 as follows:
