RESOLUTION 2023-08

A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION SETTING SOLID WASTE FEES FOR EXTRAORDINARY ITEMS AT COUNTY TRANSFER FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners has the authority to set fees in relationship to transportation and disposal of Solid Waste pursuant to Idaho Code 31-4404; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners has reviewed Resolution 2018-19 and Resolution 2021- 46 and current costs of operations; and

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing was published in the Idaho World newspaper on March 15th, 2023 and March 22nd, 2023; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on this matter on March 28th, 2023 where the Boise County Board of Commissioners considered the setting of fees to ensure that they are reasonably related to the County's costs as required by Idaho Code 31-870.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners rescinds Resolution 2018-19 and Resolution 2021- 46; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners adopts the following fee schedule for disposal of extraordinary items at the Boise County Transfer Facilities:

PASSENGER CAR & LIGHT TRUCK TIRES:	\$3.00 each without wheel 2 Free Tires Per Day
	\$5.00 each with wheel
TRUCK TIRES (20"-24.5"):	\$10.00 each without wheel
	\$20.00 each with wheel
HEAVY EQUIPMENT TIRES:	\$30.00 each without wheel
	\$40.00 each with wheel
VEHICLES: (includes Motorcycles, ATV's, Snowmobiles)	No Charge

Title must accompany all vehicles, all fluids; oil, gas and antifreeze must be drained and batteries removed
