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RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the budget for the office of Prosecuting Attorney for Boise County was duly set according to law; and

WHEREAS, by order of the Supreme Court, the several district Judges within the district have substantially curtailed their travel to Idaho City, causing the substantial additional calendaring of cases at the chambers of the District Judges in Boise, Ada County; and

WHEREAS, the economies within the budget are insufficient to meet the additional expense caused by this unforeseen expense; and

WHEREAS, the County has received \$1027.77 of unanticipated federal revenue from the federal government in accordance with Section IV-D of the Social Security Act, for the express and dedicated purpose of child support enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the office of Prosecuting Attorney has provided child support enforcement without any monies being expressly budgeted therefore.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Boise County Board of Commissioners, that the budget for the Prosecuting Attorney for fiscal year 1981 shall be amended as follows:

Line 3 - Extra Help	delete	550.00


CLASSIFICATION "B" OTHER EXPENSES

Line 6 - Bond	delete	35.00



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
