## RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, the lumber industry is an integral part of the economic life of the people in Boise County and the State of Idaho, and

WHEREAS, the current Water Quality Standards, strictly interpreted, can effectively curtail timber harvesting in Idaho, and,


WHEREAS, water quality can be protected adequately by application of "Best Management Practices" in a co-operative effort between the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare and landowners,
