RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-1604 states that the Boise County Board of Commissioners is empowered to consider budgets, and,

Whereas, Idaho Code 31-4408 states that the maintenance and/or operation of Solid Waste disposal systems shall come under the jurisdiction of the Board of County Commissioners, and,

WHEREAS, at the Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on this date a thorough review of the operation of each of the four landfills operated by Boise County and located in Lowman, Garden Valley, Horseshoe Bend and Idaho City was held.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that effective October 1, 1984, Solid Waste employees at each of the four landfills located in Lowman, Garden Valley, Horseshoe Bend and Idaho City will each be paid a salary of Four hundred fifty dollars (\$450.00) per month, and,

FURTHER, that employees will work sixteen (16) hours per week in two eight hour day shifts, and,

FURTHER, that each of the four landfills located in Lowman, Garden Valley, Horseshoe Bend and Idaho City will be open to the public fourteen (14) hours per week between the hours of 11:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. on two different days with the days of the week to be determined by the Commissioner responsible for each district, and,

FURTHER, that if it is necessary for the person hired at each respective landfill to be gone on a regularly scheduled work day, it will be the responsibility of that individual to contact the respective district's Road Foreman within a reasonable time, and,

FURTHER, that it will be the responsibility of the District Road Foreman to have the landfill open and closed and covered in the event that the person hired has given reasonable notice that he will be unavailable, and,

FURTHER, that the Road Foreman will be responsible for reporting to the Auditor before it has been necessary to hire someone extra in the event that the person hired for each landfill has not been available, and,

FURTHER, that the Road Foreman will report any extra help hiring to the Auditor on or before the twentieth of each month, and,

FURTHER, that in the event it is necessary to hire someone extra because of the unavailability of the monthly salaried person, that there will be an adjustment made in the salaried person's wages with that adjustment paid to the person hired to work in the absence of the regularly employed person, and,

FURTHER, that since these employees are classified as part-time employees of Boise County, no insurance benefits or other employment benefits will be paid by Boise County; however, employees will be given the option of being covered on the employee benefit health and dental plan on a cost-reimbursement basis, and,

FURTHER, that any present employees who have accumulated any sick time or vacation time shall use said accumulated time prior to October 1, 1984 or notify their respective Commissioner if they prefer to be compensated for the accumulated time or forfeit said time on October 1, 1984, and,

FURTHER, that this resolution shall be reviewed from time to time at the descretion of the Board of Commissioners and that adjustments or alterations shall be considered at that time, and,

FURTHER, that the effective date of this resolution shall be October 1, 1984.
