WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is necessary to set certain fees to compensate for certain procedures, and



WHEREAS, the State of Idaho is requiring that new license plates be issued for passenger vehicles, and


WHEREAS, the fee currently being charged is not adequate,



WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners is empowered to promulgate rules, fees and regulations for the processing of segregation plats,



Passed and adopted this 1st day of December, 1986.




